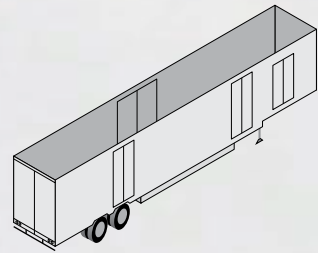


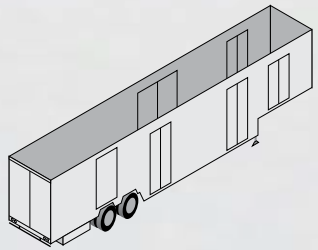
Kentucky Trailer Configurations

These cut-away diagrams are representative of Kentucky Trailer configurations. We can customize any of these trailers to fit your specific needs.



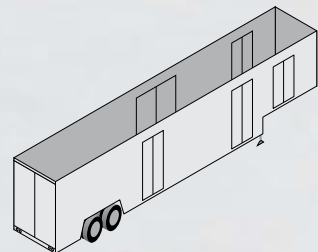
Electronic/Furniture Van

Kentucky's variety and flexibility in door sizes and placement has made it the most popular trailer for the moving industry.



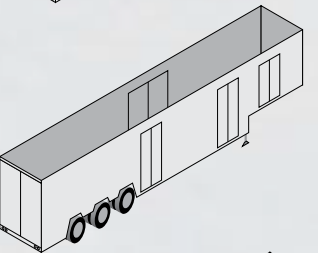
Double Drop with Electronic Tail

Part drop frame. Part electronics. It's a drop frame from the front axles. It's an electronic rear. The best of both worlds.



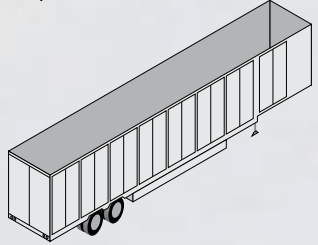
Double & Triple Drop

Need extra cube? Kentucky is the expert in drop frames.



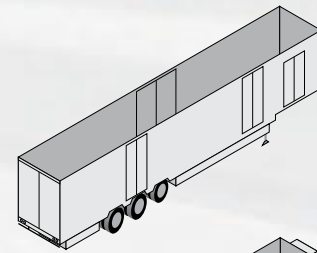
Super Bertha

The ultimate household van, this three axle trailer with single tires has enough space to load an average automobile between the wheelboxes.



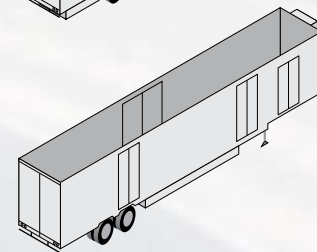
Pallet Van

Kentucky's pallet van with 66" wide doors from front to rear is ideal for palletized loads.



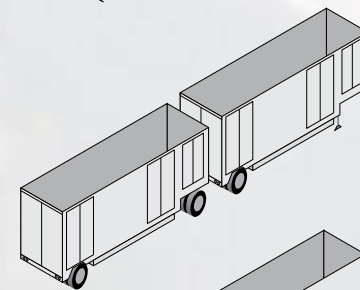
Mover Plus

The lift axle makes this trailer ideal for scaling heavy loads with 53' rigs.



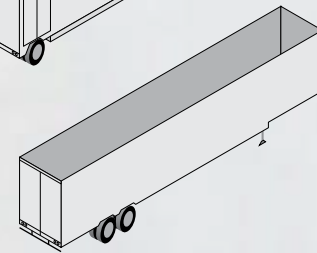
Climate Van

An insulated moving van where temperature and climate must be maintained. Includes insulated walls, doors, floors and ceiling. The front is framed and reinforced for refrigeration unit.



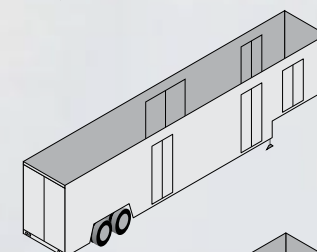
Doubles

Offers flexibility, maneuverability, and more cube.



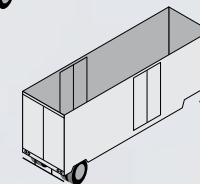
Aluminum Van or Special Commodities Van

Configurations range from a simple dry freight van to a complex unit with side doors and storage boxes.



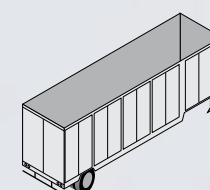
Drop Frame Furniture Van
